



### Step 1

#### Gather Your Tools

- NuGrout Application Tool (recommended) or a stiff nylon brush
- Rubber Gloves
- Clean Sponge
- Pail of warm soapy water



### Step 2

#### Apply NuGrout Cleaner & Pre-treat

For best results, use NuGrout Cleaner & Pretreat to thoroughly clean and lightly etch all grout surfaces to be coated. Always test strength on a small, inconspicuous area prior to use. **Apply a bead of NuGrout Cleaner & Pretreat to the grout joint.**



### Step 3

#### Clean All Grout Joints to be Colored

Using the NuGrout Application Tool or a stiff nylon brush, scrub grout joint until clean. Add cleaner as needed. Remove all dust, dirt, grime, soap-scum, mold, contaminants and other deleterious materials.



### Step 4

#### Remove Cleaner Residue

Thoroughly rinse grout joints with water, removing all residue. Use a clean sponge and the squeegee on the back of the NuGrout Application Tool to aid in cleanup.



### Step 5

#### Apply NuGrout Colorant & Sealer

If using more than 1 bottle of a single color for an application, mix all material together in a larger container prior to use to ensure color is consistent. Sealing of porous tile may be required prior to application. Always test color on a small, inconspicuous area prior to use.

**Apply a bead of colorant directly to grout joint.**



### Step 6

#### Brush Colorant into Grout

Spread colorant evenly onto grout surface using the NuGrout Application Tool, a good quality nylon brush or roller, working it deeply into the surface using a back-and-forth motion. For best results, apply in two coats (waiting 2-4 hours drying time between coats).



### Step 7

#### Remove Excess Colorant

Use the convenient built-in squeegee, on the back of the NuGrout Application Tool, to help remove excess product from tile and grout joints.



### Step 8

#### Clean Surface

NuGrout cleans up easily with warm, soapy water and a sponge or rag. After 30 minutes drying time (depending upon climate conditions), remove the remaining excess product from the tile using a sponge or rag, being careful not to scrub the grout joint.



### Step 9

#### Enjoy your rejuvenated tile areas!

NuGrout is ready for light foot traffic after only 2-4 hours, normal foot traffic after 24 hours, and heavy, commercial traffic after only 72 hours. Allow up to 72 hours drying time for areas subjected to high humidity.
